## Warrington District Motor Club - Stage Rally Championship - 2023

## 2023 Championship Regulations:

- All competitors must clearly state Warrington District Motor Club (or WDMC) as their club on the events entry form. As well as full crew names and constant way of displaying their.
- A single 1-point score will be awarded to any crew who start an event, but do not successfully complete the final stage.
- 25 Points will be awarded to any competitor who marshals on an event during the year. This must be an event within the ANWCC Calendar, and these points can only be claimed once during the year. TO BE NOTIFIED BY EMAIL AS PER OUT OF CALENDER RESULTS, OTHERWISE IMPOSSIBLE TO FIND THEM.
- During the year, points will be awarded for participation in any round of the ANWCC Stage Rally calendar, made up of all tarmac and all gravel events. Additional point's scores will also be awarded for participation on up to three other, non ANWCC events during the year. For these events, notification of competing and result must be provided to the championship coordinator within 21 days. IN WRITING (email)
- Each competitor's highest 5 (or up to 5 ) scores will count towards their final point score for the year. Awards will only be presented to competitors who have completed a minimum of 3 qualifying events during the year.
- At the end of the year there will be a period of 14 days during which the championship's provisional results will be available for review. Any queries regarding these that have not already been raised during the course of the year are to be raised during this period before the results are made final at the end of the 14 days. Including mid-season issuing of results
- The scoring for the club's 2023 stage rally championship is to be calculated using two separate scores combined to provide both fair and clear results. The calculation for these will be one score for a competitors overall finishing position, and the second for their class position. These are both made up as follows.


## Part 1 - Overall Score:

Number of Points Awarded = Total Number of Event Starters - Overall Finish Position

## Part 2 - Class Score:

$1^{\text {st }}$ in Class $=50$ Points
$2^{\text {nd }}$ in Class $=49$ Points
$3^{\text {rd }}$ in Class $=48$ Points
Continues down to 0 Points.

## Scoring Example:

A competitor finishing $15^{\text {th }}$ Overall and $3^{\text {rd }}$ in Class on an Event with 60 Starters
Overall $=45$ Points $(60-15)$ Class $=48$ Points
Total Points Awarded = 93 Points
